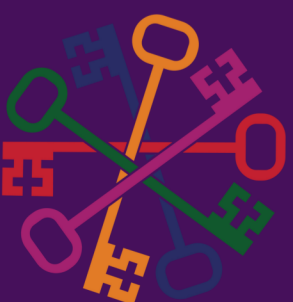

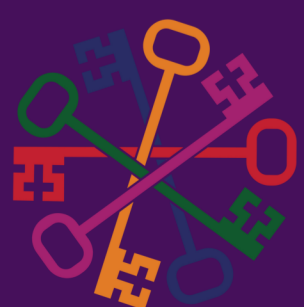
Uniform and appearance at Jack Hunt

At JHA, we believe that appearance is important. We are a uniform wearing academy for three main reasons:

1. It fosters a sense of pride & belonging
2. It prepares students for later life where most jobs have a dress code or uniform
3. It reduces pressure to wear the latest trends.

Uniform from September 2025: for ALL students (Years 7 to 11)

- Black blazer with school badge
- School tie Plain formal white shirt with collar.
- Top button must be fastened and shirt must be tucked in, all the way round. No blouses.
- Black pleated knee length skirt or plain black tailored formal trousers
- Plain mid-grey V-neck jumper or cardigan with school badge (*optional*)
- Plain black or grey socks. White socks are not permitted. Plain grey, black, or natural colour tights.
- Plain grey, white, purple, or black Hijab (if required) with no insignia
- Plain black professional business-like polishable shoes with no logos or colours. No trainers. No canvas shoes. No stripes, logos, emblems, or colours. No metal or plastic logos or tags. No heels over 2cm.
- **All black leather trainers ARE NOT PERMITTED.**

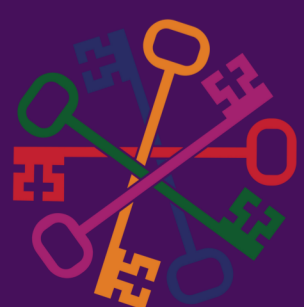
Hairstyles

Footwear

Sports trainers should be worn for PE lessons. These should have laces and not be fashion trainers. No high top trainers.

Gymnastics

All students will participate in gymnastics and dance through the PE curriculum. Students should work in **bare feet** or **gymnastic slippers** for their activities.

Protective Equipment

Students will study rugby, football and hockey in their PE lessons and or after school. Mouthguards must be worn for rugby and hockey. Shin pads must be worn for football and hockey.

If a student is unable to participate in a PE lesson due to injury or illness, they should have a note from parent/carer explaining the nature of the injury or illness. Students will still need to wear their PE uniform so they can have some active role in the lesson e.g., leader or official.
